If a driver has been suspended or excluded for any penalty other than Technical issues any points received from any class of racing during the meeting will be forfeited and they will be ineligible to receive any trophies, state plates (if applicable) etc. Technical penalties will forfeit all points, trophies, and Title plates (if applicable) for that class only.

Clearly explain the new rule/changes requested.

Currently this sits under Rule 10.17 (Appeals) However this applies to all suspensions not just those that are appealed.

The wording is to remain under Rule 10.17 to provide clarity when an appeal is lodged however it also needs to be a standalone rule under General Competition so it can be applied to any suspension.

We propose inserting this new rule as 14.33 and moving the existing 14.33 (All drivers running in engines without due care may be penalised) moved to 14.34.
