Approved by RCP to go to Clubs

Current Rule Wording (if an existing rule)
Any driver who as a result of a rollover or potentially serious injury (RED Flag/RACE stoppage) shall not be able to compete in any restart of that race, nor shall they be able to compete in any other immediate class of racing, until they have been cleared by St John or State Ambulance Service or have been observed for a minimum of 30 minutes by First Aid personnel to not have any residual effects of rollover or injury. Any person refusing assessment by First Aid personnel will be excluded from further participation in the race meeting and will be required to provide AIDKA Secretary with a medical clearance from a recognised medical practitioner to confirm the person is fit to compete in motorsport. Any person, who as a result of a rollover or potentially serious injury (Red Flag/Race Stoppage), will not receive any points for that heat.

Proposed Rule

Any driver who as a result of a rollover or potentially serious injury shall not be able to compete in any restart of that race, nor shall they be able to compete in any other immediate class of racing, until they have been cleared by St John or State Ambulance Service or have been observed for a minimum of 30 minutes by First Aid personnel to not have any residual effects of rollover or injury. Any person refusing assessment by First Aid personnel will be excluded from further participation in the race meeting and will be required to provide AIDKA Secretary with a medical clearance from a recognised medical practitioner to confirm the person is fit to compete in motorsport. Any person, who as a result of a rollover or potentially serious injury, will not receive any points for that heat.

Clearly explain the new rule/changes requested.

Remove Red Flag/Race Stoppage from wording as a red flag/race stoppage may occur for incidents other than a rollover or injury. Drivers may be injured other than during a race.

This rule was reviewed following an appeal and recommendation made by the Appeal Panel.
