Current Rule Wording (if an existing rule)
All restarts are to go back to the lap prior to the incident causing the race stoppage. Only Drivers that are recorded as completing this lap will be eligible to restart provided they have not been a kart which has rolled over or deemed to have caused the race stoppage. Restarts after 1 lap will be Single Indian File.

Proposed Rule
All restarts are to go back to the lap prior to the race stoppage. Only Drivers that are recorded as completing the lap prior will be eligible to restart provided, they have not been a kart which has rolled over or deemed to have caused the race stoppage.

Clearly explain the new rule/changes requested.

The intent of this rule change is to stop the restart order going back to when the incident occurred. There have been several cases where the red has been called multiple laps after the incident due to stewards not knowing driver if the was injured. Drivers are still competing till the red and not fair if they have gained positions in that time.

Remove the wording about Single Indian File and put into its own rule at 14.18.
