There have been several instances during events where young persons have been playing together or alone without supervision. Unfortunately, this has led to situations where inappropriate comments and/or actions were made by others. To prevent such incidents, we ask that parents and guardians always take full responsibility for supervising their children at all times during race meetings. Race meetings are exciting but inherently dangerous environments. It is crucial that parents and guardians know the

whereabouts of their children at all times to ensure their safety. Our race officials and volunteers are there to manage and run the event and ensure the smooth running of the races. They are not responsible for providing child-minding services. The safety and well-being of your children are your responsibility, and it is vital to keep them within sight and safe from potential hazards around the track. AIDKA race meetings regularly attract large numbers of people, creating a enjoyable and busy atmosphere. However, this also means that it is easy for unsupervised children to become involved in inappropriate activities. By taking an active role in supervising your children, you are contributing to a safer and more enjoyable environment for everyone.

# In preparation for the upcoming 2024 AUSTRALIAN DIRT KART TITLES



## please take a moment to check:

- that the <u>kart number</u> on your nomination matches what you have displayed on your kart. Drivers who were required to change their numbers have all be contacted. <u>NO</u> other changes will be made.
- that your <u>kart numbers</u> comply with Rules 23 to 23.8(f) of the 2024 AIDKA RULE BOOK.
- that you have entered your <u>transponder number</u> correctly on your nomination. Take a moment to check for transposed numbers or data entry errors. <u>THIS IS IMPORTANT!</u> Better to take the time to check it now than after your first heat!!
- If you find errors or you wish to change the transponder number on your nomination, please contact the AIDKA Secretary via email only to secretary@aidka.com.au immediately.
- Also just a reminder for any competitors running multiple classes, PLEASE ensure that the correct transponder is on the correct kart.
