Hosted by: Adelaide Dirt Kart Club - Speedway City Complex, 173 Supple Road Virginia SA

Date: 1st - 4th May 2025

Format: 4 x 10 lap heats and 15 lap final.

SA Champion will be determined by the finishing position of the final only.

Chief Steward has the right to decrease laps due to time constraints or move program

forward.

Classes: All Competitive Classes plus Midget & Rookie demonstration

Nominations: Competitors to nominate via the AIDKA App. NO late nominations accepted.

Nominations Open: Friday 21st February 2025

Nominations Close: Monday 31st March 2025 @ 9pm (ACDT)

Midgets / Rookies: Will be capped at the first 20 nominations, via the AIDKA App and will close on the same day as

competitive nominations, unless filled earlier. Midgets, Friday **only** & Rookies, Saturday **only** Both classes will be scheduled into the program where required. AIDKA reserves the

right to reduce or alter the Midget/Rookie schedule if time becomes an issue.

Nomination Fees: Senior & Junior \$160.00 per class

Midgets & Rookies \$40.00

Entrant Eligibility: As per Appendix A, Rules 1 & 2 in 2025 AIDKA Rule book. Please make sure you

understand the requirements prior to nominating. Drivers will need to provide a copy of their logbook (pages with the list of race meetings attended). This may mean you'll need

to provide a copy of last year's logbook too.

Kart/Race Numbers: As per 2025 AIDKA Rule Book, if one or more entrants nominate with the same racing

number in a class then the Driver with the lowest AIDKA licence number has first

preference for kart number.

Current Australian and State Title Plates are permitted to be used.

Once the AIDKA Secretary has checked and confirmed all nominations, those that need

to change race numbers will be notified via the AIDKA App.

Please make sure your email address is correct too.

Driver Registration: Will be held on Thursday 1st May from 1.00pm to 4.00pm

At Sign-In you will need to show your 'live' AIDKA licence. You will be issued with a wristband, sign the Indemnity sheet, and have your logbook filled in. Engine and Chassis seals will also be issued at this point. For drivers not attending practice there will be an

opportunity Friday 2nd May 7.30am to 8:00am to complete your registration.

Pit Crew Registration: Will be held on Thursday 1st May from 1.00pm to 4.00pm

Outside these times there will be a manned booth at the entrance to ADKC Friday – Sunday. Licenced Pit Crew will need to show their AIDKA licence and present their

logbook to sign-in. They will receive a wristband for the entire event

Rookie/Midget Registration: Will be held on Thursday 1st May from 1.00pm to 4.00pm or can be completed in

the clubrooms Friday Morning 7:00am -8.00am

EVENT DETAILS

Rules: As per 2025 AIDKA Rule Book.

Transponders: Orbits Timing Software (MyLaps) will be used in conjunction with karting compatible

transponders. Transponders are **compulsory** and must be attached prior to practice so that the system can be checked and make sure your transponder is working

correctly.

Drugs & Alcohol: Drug and Alcohol testing may occur at this event. Drivers, Officials and Pit Crew are

chosen at random throughout the event on any given day or time.

Scrutineering: Self-Scrutineering will be conducted at this event. Accredited Scrutineers will also be

conducting random spot checks throughout the event. Any items deemed unsafe will be required to be rectified before the kart can participate in any further racing. Any issue that is not rectified prior to a race commencing, may result in the offending

kart being removed from the Out Grid.

Any kart missing either an engine or chassis seal that is not rectified, may be excluded

from the race meeting.

Engine/Chassis Seals: At Driver Registration, drivers will be issued with a Chassis seal and engine seal for

the engine they are running. If they require an additional seal for spare motor, these will be available upon request from an appointed Official during the meeting.

If you are fortunate enough to be asked to present to the Engine Measuring team at the conclusion of the event, <u>all</u> engines used during the meeting (for that class) must

be presented with seal still attached.

As per Appendix A, Rule 15, Engine seals are to be fitted prior to first race. Most competitors don't attach their engine seals until after Practice. Please refer to

Appendix F with regards to fitting of Engine seals.

Pit Area Access: Must have a Title issued wrist band and enclosed shoes to enter the Pit Area.

If you are an AIDKA <u>licence holder</u> you will need to show your AIDKA licence and logbook to receive a wrist band and sign the indemnity form.

If <u>unlicensed</u>, the person will need to apply for a casual pit pass online (\$10/day) via the AIDKA App or scan the QR Code which will be available to scan throughout the public areas in our venue. Unlicensed Pit Crew will still need to receive a wristband and sign the indemnity form. We encourage people to have this done prior to the

event to keep the 'flow of traffic' running smoothly for our volunteers

If wristbands are removed prior to end of Title event, a new Pit Pass/wrist band

must be purchased.

Please note that Children under the age of 5 yrs and Adults over the age of 90 yrs are not covered by AIDKA Insurance. These people may enter our pit area at their own risk. They are still required to sign-in, wear a wrist band and sign the indemnity form acknowledging they are not covered by insurance.

Trailer Parking: Pits will be open for Trailer drop off Wednesday 30th April from 3.00pm to 7.00pm and

will reopen Thursday from 9.00am until 4.00pm. Trailers will be parked with the assistance of Pit Marshalls. Once your trailer is parked in the pit area, it will be there

for the duration of the event. All vehicles are to be removed from the Pit Area.

ADKC will be offering allocated pit space for those who request it. Please ensure that your application is in before 1st April as no spaces will be allocated after this date.

TRACK FACILITIES

Camping: Camping will be available at the venue. We also ask that everyone camps in

designated area as directed by Marshals. There will be no power available for campers and we ask that any generators are turned off by 10.30pm, out of respect

for your fellow campers.

If you need to camp in pit area, please seek permission prior to event. These type of

campers must be camping in their kart trailer/Toy Hauler etc.

Camping permits must be pre purchased via the AIDKA app before entry will be

permitted. Fee \$50 per site for the event.

NO CAMPFIRES, GAS STOVES, GAS FRIDGES ETC ARE TO BE IN PIT AREA FOR DURATION OF EVENT

Showers: There will be shower facilities available

Toilets: We have toilets near the main club rooms, as well as portable toilets around the venue

Bar: We plan to have a licensed bar open each day (pending licence approval). No

alcohol is to be brought into our premises over the course of the event. This means from Thursday morning until conclusion of activities on Sunday.
